




WORKING WITH KI REVIT FAMILIES


Why Does My Family Say, “Invalid Type”?

If the message **INVALID TYPE – Load Family with Type Catalog** is visible after loading a KI Revit family, it means no type(s) were selected from the Type Catalog or the Type Catalog failed to load with the family.



What is a Type Catalog?

A *Type Catalog* is an external text file (.txt) which lists the available family types that can be filtered and selected before loading types into a project.



Load a Family with a Type Catalog

1. Verify the Type Catalog has the same name and same location as the Revit family
2. In a Revit project, click **Load Family** under the **Insert** tab
3. Navigate to the directory containing the desired family
4. Select the family (RFA file) to load
5. Once the Type Catalog has loaded, select the family type to load into the project, use **Ctrl** to select multiple types
6. Click **OK** to load selected type(s) into the project
